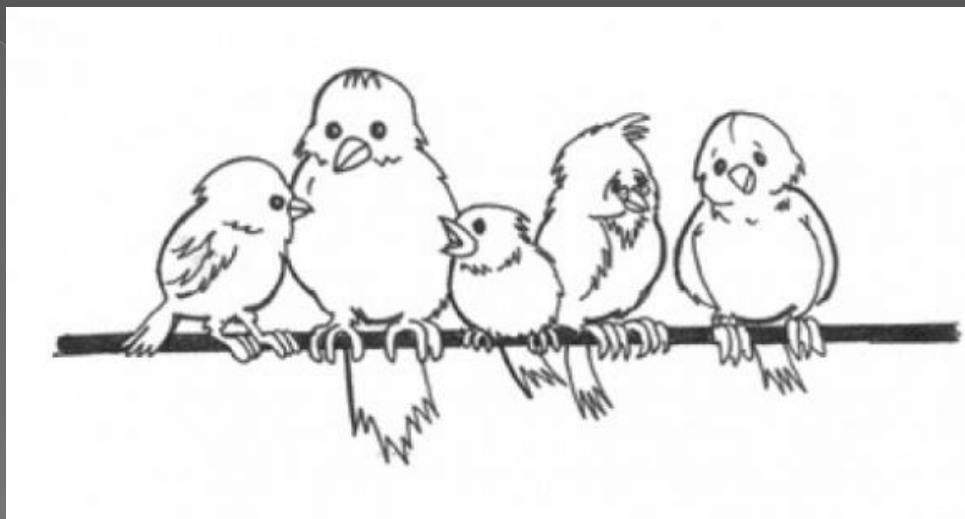


The Green Europe Birds

An eagle – a royal bird



The students made computer presentations of various species of eagles.



Haliaeetus albicilla

This bird lives in west and north part of Poland. It is a small breeding species which lives in the Plain.

Haliaeetus pelagicus

This eagle called in English Steller's sea eagle breeds on the north coast of the Pacific Ocean. It is a migratory species.





Aquila chrysaetos

This species can be found in the north Africa, middle Asia, North America and in Europe.

Aquila audax

It is sometimes known as the eaglehawk, which is the largest and the numerous bird of prey in Australia.





Aquila heliaca

It is a large species of an eagle that breeds from southeastern Europe to western and central Asia.

Aquila verreauxii

This eagle called Verreaux's eagle lives in hilly and mountainous regions of southern and eastern Africa. It lives locally in west Africa.





Aquila nipalensis

The steppe eagle breeds from southern–east steppes of Europe and Asia.

Haliaeetus leucocephalus

It is found in the United States of America. This bird is used as the National bird of the USA.





Haliaeetus vociferoides

It is found in the forests of Madagascar.

Haliaeetus leucogaster

It lives in Asia and Australia.





Stephanoaetus coronatus

This birds lives in Africa.

Harpia harpyja

It is the largest and most powerful
bird of prey that lives in
North and South America.





Milvus migrans

It is found in Europe
and western Asia.

Clanga pomarina

It lives in the southern –east
Europe and Asia Minor.





Hieraetus pennatus

This species of eagles lives
in south – east Europe.

Lophaetus occipitalis

It lives in the tropical areas
situated in the south
of Sahara Dessert.

Birds from a feeder

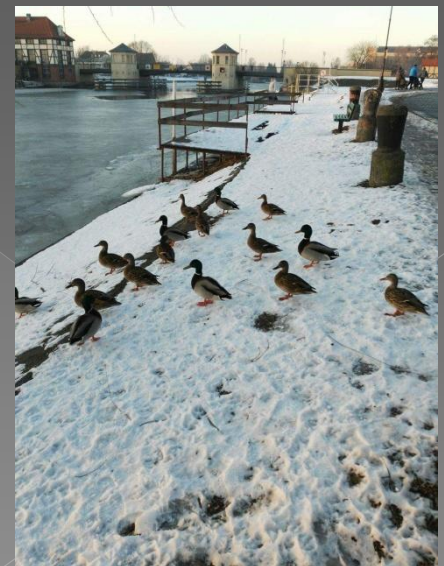
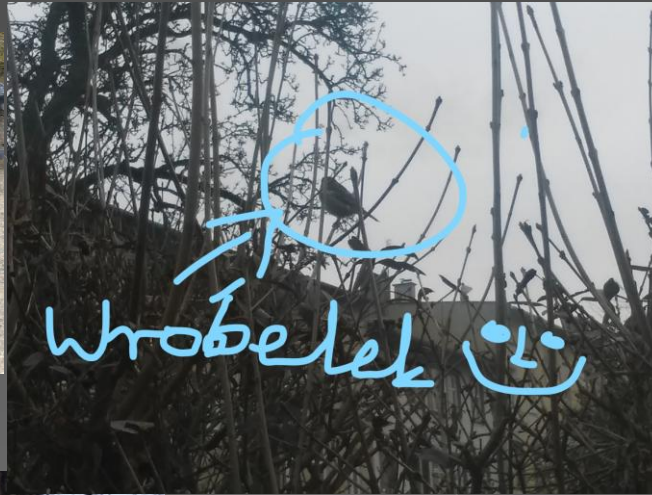
The students got to know typical birds visiting a feeder during winter.
